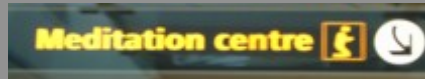


The Luchthavenpastoraat Meditation Centre

Old Catholic Anglican Airport Ministry (OCAAM)

- OCAAM seeks to promote Anglican and Old Catholic participation at the Chaplaincy of Schiphol Airport
- OCAAM is a shared responsibility of the Old Catholic Church (Diocese of Haarlem) and the Anglican Church in The Netherlands (Diocese in Europe-Church of England)
- Joop Albers has been the Old Catholic/Anglican Chaplain at Schiphol since 1st June 2007

Schiphol Airport Chaplaincy (Luchthavenpastoraat)

- The Airport Chaplaincy at Schiphol Airport, Amsterdam, provides help and assistance to passengers in distress at the Airport
- The Chaplaincy operates as an ecumenical partnership. The team includes:
 - a Roman Catholic priest
 - a Minister from the Protestant Church of the Netherlands.
 - an Old Catholic or Anglican priest
 - Part time volunteer workers
- The Chaplaincy is a member of the International Association of Civil Aviation Chaplains

- To support an Anglican or Old Catholic clergyman to minister to the workers, travellers and visitors at Schiphol Airport



- To work in ecumenical partnership with the other residential chaplains of the Roman Catholic Church and the Protestant Church Netherlands
- To continue and consolidate the Old Catholic and Anglican Chaplaincy

Objectives and Tasks

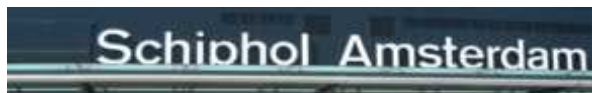
The primary objectives of the Airport Chaplains are to:

- Assist and care for passengers e.g. in cases of bereavements or other traumatic incidents
- Support the medical services for special passenger care
- Help refugees with practical problems: e.g. food, a bed for the night, directions to the appropriate authority
- Visit airport detainees in temporary custody
- Advise and help stranded passengers
- Work with airport personnel in the event of a disaster
- Lead the volunteer workers who help support distressed passengers and administer the multi-faith "Meditation Centre"
